The Corporation of the City of Belleville Wet Weather and Wastewater Servicing Master Plan

The City of Belleville (the City) has initiated a Master Planning process in accordance with Approach 1 of the Municipal Engineers Association (MEA) Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) to develop a Wet Weather and Wastewater Servicing Master Plan.

How Will This Affect Me?

The Master Plan study is assessing various options to improve the performance and reliability of the wastewater treatment and sewage collection systems to ensure they can be relied upon to manage wet weather flows and accommodate current and future wastewater flows generated within the City.

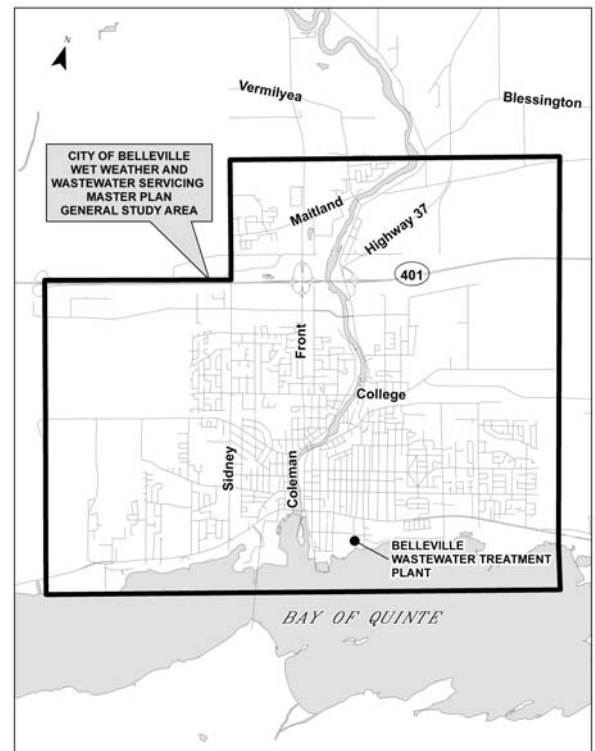
Public and agency consultation is a key part of the Master Planning process. Based on your input, the Master Plan study will identify preferred solution(s) that will benefit the community over the short, mid and long terms.

How Do I Get More Information?

A Public Information Centre will be held in late 2018 prior to confirming the preferred solution(s). In the meantime, the study team will be reviewing background information and determining alternative solutions. Updates will also be provided throughout the Master Plan study on the City's website.
