

The second of two Public Information Centres (PIC's) was held on February 4, 2015 at the Build Belleville Project Centre, as partial fulfillment of the public consultation requirements for the Sidney Street Corridor Improvements (Bell Boulevard to Tracey Street) Class Environmental Assessment.

The PIC was held from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., with representatives from the City of Belleville, CIMA+ and Golder Associates Ltd. in attendance to answer questions.

Eleven (11) information panels were on display (attached), summarizing the problem / opportunity statement for the project, the Municipal Class EA process, the findings of the background studies, the alternative designs considered, and the evaluation of the alternatives with the preferred design identified. Four (4) large drawings of the alternatives considered for Sidney Street corridor improvements was also provided for PIC attendees to identify issues / concerns with the preferred solution. Similarly, an information panel presenting alternatives considered to improve the intersection of Sidney Street / Tracey Street / Tracey Park Drive was provided for public comment.

Fourteen (14) people attended the PIC (sign-in sheet attached). Comment sheets were available to all attendees, and the information panels were posted on the City's Build Belleville website for public review. Two (2) comment sheets were returned (attached).

Issues and concerns raised by PIC attendees and noted on the received comment sheet included potential impacts related to property loss, property value, house acquisition, laneway functionality and tree removals. Only one written comment was made on the roll plans related to the location of the proposed sidewalk and existing trees. These concerns were discussed at the PIC, and will be documented in the Environmental Study Report.
