3) New Business

- a. Bay Bridge Rd/ Dundas St West Project
- The tender for this project is scheduled to be issued July 30th. This will allow for the contract to be awarded in September, with work commencing on Bay Bridge Road in the fall and continuing over the winter months. Work on Dundas Street West would commence in spring 2016, with full project completion scheduled for fall 2016.
- The City has yet to receive a decision regarding Small Communities infrastructure funding. If the City's application is approved a change to the project scope will be addressed at that time.
- A list of events taking place at Zwick's Park that may be impacted will be reviewed and project staff will consult event organizers in advance to determine any necessary plans required.

b. Old Highway 2 Completion

- Final paving is ongoing and will be complete by end of July.
- Street light installation and final clean-up complete by mid-August.
- Highway includes wider shoulder to accommodate future potential bike lanes.
- Event will be planned to recognize completion of project with members of Council and project staff.
 - c. City Centre Revitalization Update
- CCRR project is moving along accordingly.
- Nearing completion with underground infrastructure at Station Street.
- Traffic was successfully switched end of June with no issues to date.
- Street light shop drawings are currently under review.
- A notice was distributed regarding a partial closure of Front Street from Victoria
 Avenue to the north entrance of the Riverside Parking Lot. This closure is to
 accommodate installation of the sanitary main over 7 working days. An
 alternative route will be available through the Riverside Parking lot during this
 closure with entrance at the south parking lot and exit at the north.
