



NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

Mineral Road EA Study, Maitland Drive EA Study and Farnham Road Master Plan

The City of Belleville has completed the overall planning of three roadways in the City following the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process for Mineral Road, Maitland Drive and Farnham Road. The roadways under study and the applicable Municipal Class EA schedules include:

- Mineral Road - Schedule C Municipal Class Environmental Assessment has been completed.
- Maitland Drive - Schedule C Municipal Class Environmental Assessment has been completed.
- Farnham Road – A Master Plan has been prepared following Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment.

An Environmental Study Report and preliminary design for the Mineral Road and Maitland Drive projects is complete. This will be followed by the detailed design and construction of the road improvements and municipal servicing for Mineral Road and Maitland Drive.

The Farnham Road portion of the study is a Master Planning level of study only. A separate Environmental Assessment and Environmental Study Report will be required in the future in advance of the construction of Farnham Road improvements.

If concerns regarding the Mineral Road EA Study or the Maitland Drive EA Study cannot be resolved in discussion with the City, a person or party may request that the Minister of the Environment make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the *Environmental Assessment Act* (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses Individual Environmental Assessments. Requests must be received by the Minister by January 15, 2016, with a copy sent to the City Project Manager. If there are no requests by this date, the City of Belleville may proceed with detail design construction of the Mineral Road and Maitland Drive projects.
