

Bay Bridge Road and Dundas Street West Reconstruction Update

Belleville, December 9, 2016 – The City of Belleville is pleased to report on the progress of the Bay Bridge Road and Dundas Street West Reconstruction Project. The Project is winding down for a scheduled winter break but will resume activity in the spring of 2017.

The Bay Bridge Road and Dundas Street West Reconstruction Project is one of the City's largest Build Belleville projects. It includes the replacement of the Bay Bridge Road CP Rail Overhead Structure, the reconstruction of Dundas Street West from Coleman Street to Bay Bridge Road, and the resurfacing of Dundas Street West from Bay Bridge Road to Sidney Street.

"This project is a game-changer for the City of Belleville," says Mayor Christopher. "In addition to addressing aging infrastructure issues, this project will significantly improve the daily flow of thousands of people to the City to visit and do business."

Notable achievements in 2016 for this complex project included the replacement of the 50 year-old overpass with a brand new five-lane structure; 1.3 kilometers of total road reconstruction on Dundas Street West and Bay Bridge Road; the addition of turning lanes; the replacement of 0.5 kilometers of watermain that was constructed in the 1930s; the construction of a 1.3 kilometer multi-use path and the addition of 1380 square metres of retaining walls.

In 2017, residents and commuters will see the completion of impressive gateway features that will include a public viewing area overlooking the Bay and Zwicks Park, modern landscape design elements and the completion of a multi-use pathway that will connect cyclists and joggers/walkers to the waterfront trail network.
