PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PROJECT

The City of Belleville will be rehabilitating the Northern portion of Old Madoc Road from the North intersection of Highway No. 62, southerly approximately 1.8 km as part of the Build Belleville program and the ongoing upgrades of the City's aging infrastructure.



The proposed rehabilitation includes:

- A new asphalt driving surface
- Widening and asphaltting of the shoulders to match the widths of the remainder of the road reconstructed in 2002
- Installation of steel beam guiderail for roadside safety in the wetland area
- Drainage improvements to some of the roadside ditches
- Removal and replacement of some roadway and driveway culverts (this may require some localized daily road closures and detours)

PROJECT COST

The total estimated project cost is approximately \$535,000.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Design Completed.....July, 2013
- Issuance of Tender.....August, 2013
- Council Award of Tender.....August 12, 2013
- Construction.....End of August to the end of October, 2013

A Project Notice from the Contractor undertaking the work will be delivered to residents prior to the commencement of construction.
