



Funding is still available to help improve building façades in the Belleville Downtown Improvement Area (BDIA). Owners, or tenants with owner's permission, can apply for Grants of up to half of the cost of exterior improvements. Grants will be allocated to projects that make overall improvements to buildings that are sympathetic to traditional façades and compatible with adjacent buildings. Maximum Grant amounts are as follows:

- \$7,500 for a single wall (façade); and
- \$10,00 for two (2) facades (for example front and side, or front and rear)

A maximum of one (1) application per property per year is allowed, and only one Grant may be issued per façade. The Program encourages improvements to an entire building face, including such components as uncovering original brick and masonry, cleaning and restoration, painting, window and door repair, and limited funding for signs and awnings. Applications will continue to be accepted until all funds have been allocated.
