Cycling Facilities

Share The Road



•"Sharrows" direct cyclists where to travel within a lane and remind motorists to share the road

On The Road Bike Lanes



 Painted lane providing dedicated space solely for cyclist use, typically adjacent to the curb

Multi-Use Pathway



- Path located within the road rightof-way which may be shared with pedestrians
- Completely separated from the road by a grass or paved boulevard

Off Road Trails



 Active transportation path through open or park space, not within road right-of-way

Cycling 101

Rules of the Road

- •Bikes are classified as a vehicle under Ontario's Highway Traffic Act
- •Cyclists must obey all traffic laws, have the same rights and responsibilities as drivers
- •Cyclists must stay as close to the right edge of the road whenever possible
- •Cyclists under the age of 18 must wear an approved helmet


